

Before use

Camera handling


- Keep the camera away from excessive vibration, force, or pressure.
- The camera is not dust resistant, splash resistant, or waterproof. Avoid using the camera in places with excessive dust or sand, or where water can come into contact with the camera.

Condensation (When the lens or the LCD monitor is fogged up)

- Condensation may occur when the camera is exposed to sudden changes of temperature or humidity. Avoid these conditions, which may make the lens or LCD monitor dirty, cause mold, or damage the camera.
- If condensation does occur, turn off the camera and wait about two hours before using it. Once the camera adjusts to the surrounding temperature, the fogging will clear naturally.







About batteries that you can use with this unit

The battery that can be used with this unit is DMW-BCK7PP.

- Use the dedicated charger and battery.
- The battery is not charged when the camera is shipped. Charge the battery and set the clock before use.
- Charge the battery with the charger indoors (10 $^\circ\text{C}$ to 30 $^\circ\text{C}$ (50 $^\circ\text{F}$ to 86 $^\circ\text{F}$)).

Inserting and removing the card (optional)/ the battery


Turn off the power and slide the card/battery door out (①) before opening the door (②) as illustrated

Insert the battery and card, making sure that their orientation is correct

- Battery: Insert all the way firmly until a locking sound is heard, and check that the lever is hooked over the battery.
- Card: Insert all the way firmly until it clicks.



■To remove

• To remove battery: Move lever in direction of arrow.





• To remove card: Press down in center.
